Doing research can be a difficult task for a lot of students. In order to help the students focus on pertinent and scholarly information, the librarians in the Library will assist faculty in providing supplemental research sites for the course being taught. The format will be a handout which may be given to the students. This handout may be a **Resource Guide** which consists of:

- ? a brief list of reference titles found in the Library
- ? a list of journals to which the Library subscribes in a particular discipline
- ? ranges of Library of Congress call numbers for focused shelf browsing
- ? appropriate databases within NCLIVE and others to which we may subscribe
- ? a short list of appropriate web sites for further research

Alternately, the handout may be a **Webliography**, which is a list of good Internet sites of a professional and scholarly nature.
