Associate in Arts: Communication Pathway

All Pathways are designed to transfer to a four-year institution for eventual completion of a BA/BS degree.

Communication as a field of study helps students develop analytical skills and proficiency in comprehension and interpretation, as well as, in writing, and speaking. The field covers all aspects of human communication and the Communication Pathway at A-B Tech prepares transfer students for majors in communication studies, mass communication, journalism, public speaking, media production, public relations, advertising and marketing, or any combination of these disciplines.

A communication degree can prepare students for positions that value well-crafted, targeted, multi-channel messages in media relations and/or production, corporate training, public relations, politics, education, and business. Communication majors develop skills in critical thinking, media literacy, visual literacy, research based analysis, public speaking, conflict management, and human communication competencies.
