What's the process for using the online service?

Send an email from your college account to writingcenter@abtech.edu. Include the following information in your email:

- Your student ID number
- Instructor's full name
- Course title and section number
- A focused question or two about your draft

Attach your draft and the assignment prompt as word documents or PDFs in the email.

*No Googledocs or links to Moodle courses, please.

How do on-campus appointments work?

While all appointments are different, you can expect your session to follow a general sequence:

- Discuss assignments and main concerns or questions.
- Read over draft with tutor (if applicable).
- Tutor will respond to your concerns and outline her/his observations from the draft.
- Tutor will help you develop a revision plan.
- To conclude the appointment, your tutor will draft a short, non-evaluative conference summary that outlines your progress during the session. In support of your continued writing growth, tutors will send summaries to instructors.
